## 1 CITY: LAGOS

Its long history is reflected in the diversity of attractions that spread throughout the city: the ancient Moorish walls stand out, also a 17th-century fortress and extravagant Baroque churches. Not forgetting the wide variety of beautiful beaches.

## 1 BEACH: MARINHA - LAGOA

It is one of the most famous beaches in Portugal, considered by the Michelin Guide as one of the 10 most beautiful in Europe and one of the 100 most beautiful in the world. Here you can take the emblematic picture of the heart on the rocks.

## 1 EVENT: FEIRA DE SANTA IRIA FARO

With several centuries of history, it is one of the oldest and most traditional fairs in the region. There are manuscripts that report to the year 1596 as the first fair. Ideal for enjoying regardless of age.

## TO VISIT IN 1 DAY: TAVIRA

It features a panoramic medieval castle and the church of Santa Maria do Castelo. It also has a beach (Tavira Island). From Faro you can get on the train and to go to the Island you have to take a ferryboat.

## 1 SPOT FOR SUNSET: FARO'S MARINA

## 1 ISLAND: FAROL

The island has the Lighthouse, which gives it its name, where it is possible to climb at some times of the year, the traditional village of local fishermen, white sand and some options of bars and restaurants. You can reach by ferry from Faro or Olhão.



## 1 FOOD: CATAPLANA

It is a fish or seafood stew that can also have some kind of garnish, steamed in a copper container called cataplana, which gives the dish its name. You can eat at "Chefe Branco" in Faro.

## 5 THINGS YOU CAN'T SKIP IN FARO

A walking tour (departures from the "Arco da Vila"); visit Centro de Ciência Viva (great for kids); visit the Carmo's Church and the Bones Chapel; visit one of the many islands or just take the ferryboat to Faro Island; do the Ludo Trail, close to the beach.

## 5 THINGS YOU CAN'T SKIP IN ALGARVE

Visit Estói's Palace; São Lourenço's Church in Al Mancil; Benagil's beach (and the caves); Ponta da Piedade, in Lagos, a natural monument; Algar Seco and Carvoeiro's beach, to be amazed with the stunning views, the rocks and the caves.
